MIRAGE would like to invite artists to share their insights and make these visible to the public. During the month of August, MIRAGE Contemporary Art Space aims to provide insight of the growing creative scene in Cambodia.

With this Open Call #MIRAGEinsight, we invite artists in Cambodia and the region, as well as Cambodian artists living abroad, to submit their digital artworks created during the recent months. The submissions will be reviewed, and each selected artwork will be projected once at MIRAGE Contemporary Art Space in Siem Reap, Cambodia on one out of two screening nights during August 2020.

In addition to that, MIRAGE is hosting a special feature projection night with Angkor Photo Festival on July 31, 7pm

Criteria for Submission:

- Digital Artwork with or without audio (*short film, motion graphics, kinetic type, photography sequence, digital illustration / animation, video art, music video, etc.*)
- Duration of the submitted artwork does not exceed 30 minutes
- The artist is either living / staying in Cambodia and / or the surrounding countries while creating the submitted artwork, or has Cambodian origins.
- Submission Deadline is July 31, 12:00pm (noon) Phnom Penh Time
- Submissions are only accepted via email
- The submitting artist must be the creator and own all copyrights of the submitted artwork.
- By submitting the artwork, the artist agrees with all of the conditions listed above.

MIRAGE Contemporary Art Space is led by a collective of Cambodian and international artists and creatives. We focus on presenting and empowering Khmer artists and to make their art accessible to both a local and international audience. Since 2018, we have curated, designed and hosted over a dozen exhibitions and art events showcasing Khmer artists. Our approach is community driven, and each exhibition is accompanied by educational events such as art talks and workshops. Besides hosting changing art exhibitions at our gallery in the city center of Siem Reap, we regularly work with like-minded organisations and individuals in co-hosting cultural and artistic events. These include pop-up design markets, short film nights, skateboarding contests and school trips to visit art exhibitions. We also collaborate with schools and youth organisations and aim at making the world of art accessible to the younger generations. We understand our art gallery as a space for Cambodian artists to express themselves freely and connect with a wide audience and artists from all over the world.

Our mission is that of re-discovery, presentation and preservation of Khmer art and culture, operating in a multicultural and inclusive manner, promoting artists and performers that fully reflect the cultural diversity of Cambodia. We believe that artists and creative professionals need to experiment, bounce ideas off one another and work in a collaborative manner to create their next master work. MIRAGE offers this kind of space to local, regional and international arts professionals and emerging artists to exhibit, perform, meet, share, influence, collaborate and amalgamate ideas and inspirations. At MIRAGE we seek to enhance the cultural landscape of Siem Reap by bringing artists from other Cambodian cities and from neighboring ASEAN countries, reaching new audiences, and generating dialogue with and around contemporary arts.
